I think of my installation as a story through visual representation. In the first picture the audience

sees a human face and body made out of plastic bottles, caps, masks, straws, etc that represents

how people over consume plastic products and then dispose it into the sea (Picture 2) from which

they eventually drink from (Picture 3). The irresponsible disposal phenomenon doesn't only affect

human beings but also affects sea animals (Picture 4) who live under water and who drink the sea

animals consuming plastic that they can't digest. Although people may initially tend to believe

that they are simply getting rid of their trash by disposing them in the sea or even throwing on the
